Saxophonist Branford Marsalis and organist Jean-Willy Kunz play a concert featuring the newly-reinstalled 1932 Aeolian-Skinner pipe organ at Northrop Auditorium on the University of Minnesota's Main Campus in Minneapolis. Admission.

Combining saxophone and pipe organ may seem like an improbable duo, but acclaimed saxophonist Branford Marsalis, specialist of both jazz and classical music, and Jean-Willy Kunz, famed pipe organist and Orchestre Symphonique de Montréal's first organist-in-residence, have created this crossover concert full of surprising discoveries. *All About Jazz* raves, "Multi-genre music is a global phenomenon today. What singled out this concert from the crowd was the extraordinary virtuosity and rapport of Marsalis and Kunz on two infrequently paired instruments...and their excellent choice of classical pieces that could be readily appreciated by jazz fans."

This past Sunday we gathered at Central Lutheran Church in Minneapolis for the opening event of the TCAGO programming season: a recital of Scandinavian organ music performed by James Hicks, followed by the annual members dinner and chapter meeting.



For my money, the event embodied the kind of satisfying and stimulating offering typical of our chapter and its events. We were treated to a concert that was immensely varied, played with impressive expressive and technical skill, exploring an unfamiliar realm of organ music, using the rich and colorful resources of the pipe organ in a beautiful setting. The social and dinner that followed afforded the opportunity to connect with colleagues and friends, to enjoy good food and drink, and to celebrate the life of our guild and her members. The whole event was the result of excellent collaboration, in this case between the chapter and the hosting church. We're off to a great start, and I'm sure you will continue to find something that will excite your interest among the events being offered this coming season.

AGO Initiative

The AGO has just started a pilot program directed toward volunteer church musicians that offers a reduced price for a six-month welcome membership, renewable for a special annual dues rate. The VocalEssence Ensemble Singers, joined by Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra associate concertmaster Ruggero Alliffranchini on violin, will give two performances of the concert *Divine Light*, featuring songs that evoke an other-worldly connection.

The compositions for this special performance were selected specifically for the extraordinary venue. Once known as St. Paul's Episcopal Church on the Hill, the Summit Avenue building now known as the Summit Center for Arts & Innovation was designed by French immigrant Emmanuel Masqueray, architect of the Cathedral of Saint Paul and the Basilica of St. Mary. Its stunning acoustics led to a second life as a concert performance venue, which opened just this year.

The two performances of *Divine Light* will be preceded by a talk about the story behind the songs by VocalEssence artistic director Philip Brunelle. The first pre-concert talk will start at 3:00 p.m., with the concert beginning at 4:00 p.m. The second pre-concert talk will start at 6:00 p.m., with the concert beginning at 7:00 p.m.

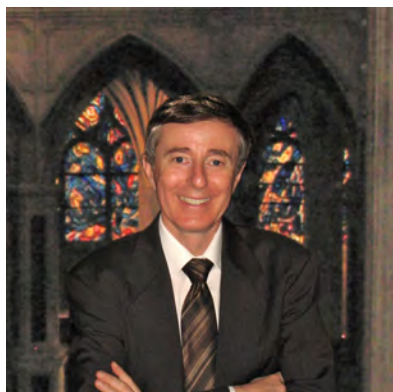

Prize-winning French organist Christophe Mantoux will perform on the 40-rank Glatter-Götz/Rosales organ at Augustana Lutheran Church. The recital is free and open to the public; a freewill offering will be taken. All are invited to a reception following the recital.



Mantoux is Professor of Organ at the *Pôle Supérieur* and the *Conservatoire Régional de Paris* where he

teaches students from all over Europe, the United States, South America, South Korea, and Japan. He also holds the post of Titular Organist at the historic Church of Saint-Séverin in Paris, where he has served since 1995.

In 1984, Mr. Mantoux won the prestigious *Grand Prix d'Interprétation* (First Prize in Interpretation) at the Chartres International Organ Competition (*Grand Prix de Chartres*). Following that success, he served as Titular Organist of the historic Chartres Cathedral from 1986 to 1992, and he remains a member of the Artistic Committee of the Chartres International Organ Competition.

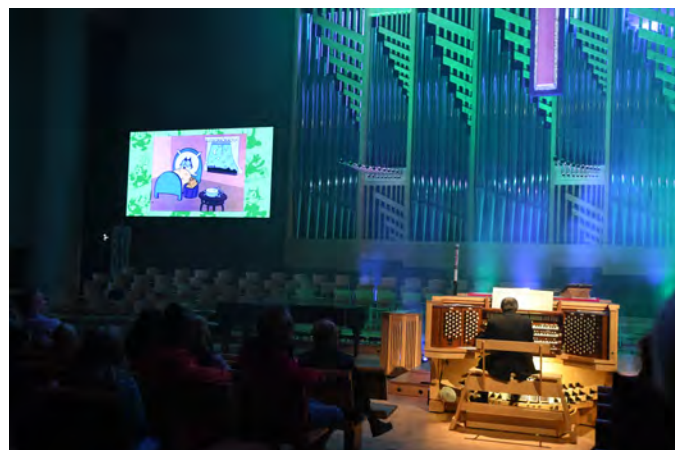

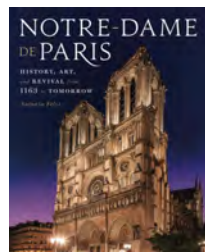
